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SPECIFIC ASPECTS OF IMPROVING LEGAL EDUCATION OF YOUNG PEOPLE

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Abstract: This article describes the role of young people in today's reforms and the fact that they are the foundation of our future, as well as their legal knowledge and legal views, the theoretical and practical importance of improving the legal education of young people in Uzbekistan.

Today, in the conditions of the rapid development of science and technology, as each country draws up its future plans, it is the demand of the time to pay special attention to the development of the abilities of the young generation who will implement them in the future, to increase their intellectual potential, and to enrich their spirituality.

In the years of independence, large-scale reforms aimed at bringing up the young generation as perfect human beings were carried out. Particular importance was attached to the comprehensive protection and guarantee of the constitutional rights and interests of young people, ensuring continuity, continuity and consistency in their education, encouraging the initiative and talent of young people, and supporting the activities of youth organizations. As a result of this, our young people have successfully participated in various prestigious international competitions, festivals, science Olympiads, and sports competitions, proving to the world that they are worthy successors of their great ancestors. Consequently, the issue of youth in our country has risen to the level of state policy, and the necessary conditions are being created to bring them up as a highly moral, intelligent, knowledgeable generation capable of taking responsibility for the country's destiny.

Regarding the issue of youth, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. Mirziyoev: "Let all leaders know one thing: working with young people, who are the owners of

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our tomorrow, is a matter of life and death for us!" If we don't create conditions for young people from today, if we don't put forward revolutionary initiatives to support them, how will we build New Uzbekistan?

In our country, 2024 was declared as the Year of Youth and Business Support. It is no exaggeration to say that this is a recognition of the important role of the youth of our country in the implementation of goals such as the development and growth of our country, a prosperous life and a decent life for citizens, and a place in the ranks of advanced societies in the world.

On June 30, 2017, the Youth Union of Uzbekistan was established, and its main goal was to support and implement all initiatives of young people. In turn, according to the proposal of the President, June 30 was declared as "Youth Day" by the law "On Establishing Youth Day in the Republic of Uzbekistan".

Today, legal education, especially the legal education of young people, serves as an important factor in establishing a democratic legal state and civil society in our country, implementing socio-economic, political and legal reforms, ensuring legality, and increasing the legal consciousness and culture of the population. Protection of citizens' rights and freedoms, enforcement of laws adopted by state authorities is closely related to the level and effectiveness of legal education.

The issue of legal education is a decisive factor in the further development of our country, and it is given extraordinary importance. Constitution and laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan, decrees of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistanand the main principles of state and economic reform, which are strengthened in the decisions of the Cabinet of Ministers, create the necessary legal basis for the determination of democratic norms and social guarantees.

Legal education is a complex and multifaceted activity system. The term "education" is a social category that is repeated many times in human society in everyday life. Education **is** a practical pedagogical process aimed at forming certain physical, mental, moral and spiritual qualities in a person; is a set of measures taken to ensure that a person has the characteristics necessary for living in society. As a result of many thousand years of development of mankind, a system of social education was formed that serves people to live together in one society.

The great thinker Abdulla Avloni said, "Education is for us either life or death, or salvation or destruction, or happiness or disaster."He did not point out that for nothing.

Because such categories as "legal awareness, legal education and legal culture" are

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inextricably linked and complementing each other, located in this logical consistency and sequence, indicate the state of the society's legal system.

In the system of social education, legal education, like other types of education, is of special importance. Legal education is formed and develops on the basis of moral, cultural, spiritual, political, legal and other types of social education. In a word, legal education is closely related to all types of social education.

The essence of legal education is the formation of legal instructions, attitudes, and motivations for activity in the field regulated by law. With the help of legal education, a person develops an attitude towards law as a value, obeying laws becomes a habit, a sense of respect for the state is formed as a phenomenon that ensures the stability of society, and cooperation with state bodies and public organizations develops in strengthening legality and legal order.

The process of legal education serves to form a person who knows the human being as a supreme value, has an active citizenship position, obeys the law, values and protects human rights and freedoms, and has deep legal knowledge.

It is also worth noting that education of legal consciousness consists not only of expanding knowledge about law, forming a positive attitude towards it as a social value of society, but also education of legal skills and habits is extremely important. At the same time, this is a more complex task than the formation of legal consciousness.

The research shows that, in most cases, law-abiding citizens and law-abiding citizens are almost identical in terms of knowledge of the law. But the acquisition of legal behavioral skills in relation to law is significantly different from each other.

Legal education is a structurally complex phenomenon. Researchers distinguish three interrelated aspects of legal education: *the first* is the formation of a system of legal knowledge (the closest goal); *the second*, the formation of firm confidence (intermediate goal); *the third* is the formation of legal, socially active behavior, habits and skills ¹.

"The category of "legal education" has been interpreted and commented on by scholars in different ways. "Legal education is a process of pedagogical influence on the legal consciousness of individuals and social groups, directed to specific goals, planned and carried out by means of special legal education methods."

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Legal education provides citizens with legal knowledge absorbing important social tool is to influence a person's legal awareness, legal instructions, law-abiding behavioral skills and habits, organized, systematic, with a clear goal in mind.

In general, legal education *is* a special activity of government bodies, non-governmental organizations, officials and groups of individuals aimed at improving the legal consciousness and culture of the population.

As a result of legal education, the following complex tasks are solved: *firstly*, to provide students with the skills of independent application of legal knowledge acquired in practical activities, in evaluating their own and other persons' behavior; *secondly*, forming guidelines for the implementation of only legal actions in accordance with the law and other regulatory legal documents; *thirdly*, it allows to cultivate the virtue of being intolerant of any offense. The legal knowledge obtained only in this way serves to create a system of strict habituation to act in accordance with the law in any situation, and to actively fight against the violation of law ².

Acquiring legal education is a process that can be carried out at a certain stage of a person's life. Failure to carry out training for a certain period of time makes it difficult to deliver it in the next stages. First of all, it is related to the age characteristics of a person, and it is related to the decrease in his ability to study and learn, to external influences in the form of education.

According to the researchers, if a person does not have the necessary education, including legal education, before the age of 30, his ability to re-educate in the direction required by society in the later periods of his life will decrease. It becomes a difficult task to change the formed thoughts, beliefs and worldview. For the same reason, legal nihilism is common among people over 30-35 years old.

On the contrary, among persons studying in schools, lyceums, colleges and higher educational institutions until the age of 30, the right understanding of the law and the feeling of following it are more developed. They quickly develop skills for changes in society, including changes in the field of law, understand changes in legislation.

The time demands the need to raise the legal education to a new level in accordance with the requirements of the population, especially among the youth. The analysis of crimes shows that serious types of crimes such as murder, defamation, robbery, robbery, and drug addiction are committed by minors and young people in general. Crimes, including crimes, show that instead of the formation of a sense of obedience to the law and respect for the rights of young people

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who commit crimes, selfishness promoted by "popular culture", getting easy wealth, fear of others, violence, luxury, and the feeling of living in luxury are given priority.

Today, in our country, young people under 18 make up about 40 percent of the population, and those under 30 make up 64 percent. This requires a fundamental reconstruction of the activities of legal education entities, legal education of young people as the main direction of our activity.

Legal education should be provided from a young age, every person should understand that legal responsibility is expected for the illegal behavior committed by him. Everyone is a component of society and is obliged to follow the rules established by the state in all spheres of social life every day. If this process becomes a habit of every member of the society, the country will become a legal state. That is why it is an important direction of the educational influence of law, which is manifested in the formation of the habit of observing the requirements of legal and other social norms. Data is formed as a result of systematic repetition of one or another perceived actions.

As a conclusion, it should be emphasized that in order to choose the right educational tools, it is important to determine the factors that shape one or another character of a person: social status, educational system, family, community, etc. Educating a person means taking into account all the listed factors. The educational effect of the law is that it creates conditions for people to learn advanced political, legal, ethical and other views, it creates an opportunity to master the important principles and basic rules of society. Cultural and legal upbringing of a person characterizes the level of his personal consciousness, expresses his mentality, worldview and assessment, and determines the behavior of a person in the field of legal order.
