At the same time, some professions may absent likely including translator, language teachers, interpreter and others related to language fields. It causes the growth of unemployment rate worldwide. The educational centers, publishing houses fail into financial decay. The imposition of the universal language could guide to insecure linguistic imperialism due to the dominance of one language (for example English) namely that of nation is pushed onto others. Phillipson (2009) conducted the survey about how the spread of global language (English) can be dominant and marginalize other languages and cultures respectively [9].


Methodology

Opinions about online impacts of the universal language



Opinions about the effects of the universal language to literature




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


The development of several fields by the universal language (English)
